

How to find us



Directions by Road

From the M5 North

Travelling from the North and Midlands, take the M5 to junction 17. Follow the A4018 signposted to Clifton, A4176 for the Zoo and second left (after the Zoo) into Clifton Down. Follow through into Clifton Down Road which leads onto Regent Street, past two zebra crossings into Clifton Hill. The hospital is on the left hand side. The entrance is clearly signposted on your left at the beginning of Clifton Hill.

From the M5 South

Travelling up from Cornwall, Devon and Somerset take the M5 to junction 19. Follow the A369 to Clifton, crossing the Suspension Bridge (toll fee £1), turn right at the next roundabout into Clifton Down Road and Regent Street (then as above).

From the M4 West and East

From London and the West take the M4 to junction 19, and the M32 to the City Centre. Follow signs to the Bus Station and Bristol Royal Infirmary and on up to Clifton. Bear left at the Victoria Rooms (large fountains at the front) into Queen's Road and all the way to the T-junction at the end. Turn left into Regent Street and the hospital is located approximately 100 yards down on your left. The entrance is clearly signposted on your left at the beginning of Clifton Hill.

Parking

There is patient parking onsite, street parking immediately adjacent to the building and additional parking available in Bristol City Council West End Car Park, situated in Berkeley Place within easy walking distance (shown on map).



By Cycle

Cycling is a quick and sustainable way to travel to the hospital. The Chesterfield is surrounded by quiet roads which are marked as recommended cycle routes by other cyclists as shown on the Bristol City Cycle Maps. Cycle parking is conveniently provided for visitors and patients adjacent to the main Chesterfield Hospital building.

Bv Rail and Bus

Rail passengers are recommended to alight at Bristol Temple Meads Station. Bristol Parkway is further away on the outskirts of the city. From Temple Meads or from Bristol Bus/Coach Station you have the choice of a taxi, or bus 8 or 9 to Clifton Village.

By Bus from Southmead

If you are travelling from Southmead Hospital or UWE campus take the 505 service and alight at Clifton village as above.
